



No Fake Emergencies

The Oregon Constitution guarantees that the citizens of the State of Oregon, through the referendum process, have the right to effectively veto any Act of the Legislature...unless it's an emergency.

What is an "Emergency Clause?"

The people of the State of Oregon retain the right to veto any act of the legislature, unless it has an Emergency Clause, where the bill is declared to be an Emergency. Then, the people cannot veto the act. Legislators have been using this as a way to keep people from using this process to overturn their legislation. It's an abuse of the process.

What do you propose?"

This measure would require a 2/3 majority to pass any bill that has an emergency clause.

It takes 149,360 signatures to put a measure on the ballot which changes the constitution, for this cycle. That means we need to gather about 200 signatures per day.

Signatures have to be turned in by July 2, 2022.
